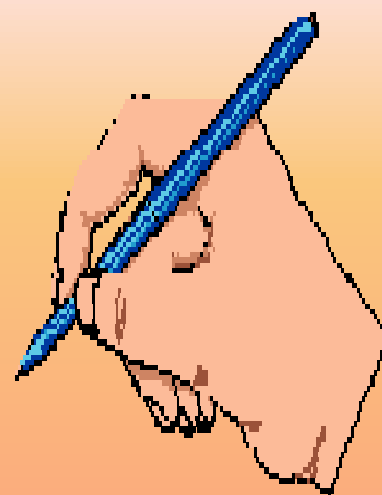

SERVICE TO HUMANITY”**

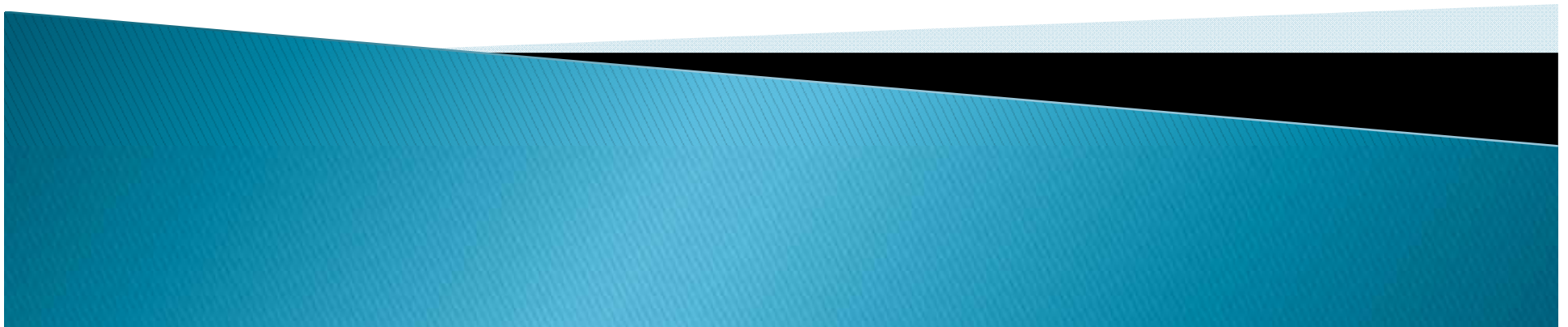

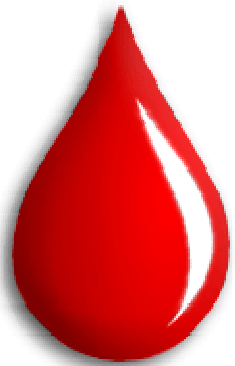

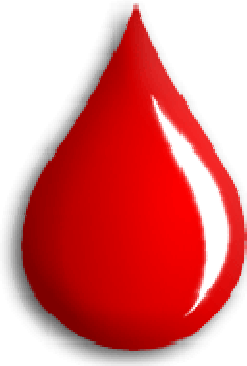
DELIVERIES AND SURGERIES IN THE YEAR-2012

DON BOSCO (DB TECH SKILL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME)



JMJ have taken step to collaborate with Don Bosco Tech India which is one of the Government scheme Swarna jayanthi Gram Swarojgar Yojana (SGSY) from December 2011 onwards. This scheme is for the rural BPL youth of the Country. Training is for 2 months. Free Food and accomodation is given by the hospital premises.

No. Of youth trained for Hospitality – 82 and Sales Marketing–106 No. of Youth Job placement done is 90%.

We envisaged this program so that it will eradicate school drop outs, child laborers and young at risk. Develop in them the human and religious values in order to make themselves socially acceptable and dignified citizens in the society.
