Group Activity

Group exercises examine how individuals respond in a **group**and/or problem-solving situation. Usually a **group** would consist of 6 - 8 candidates and a number of assessors would observe from a distance. The following are some of the skills that are being assessed

The aims of working in small groups include the development of: intellectual understanding, abilities and skills. Communication, cooperative and teamwork skills such as **planning**, management, **leadership** and peer support. Personal growth (increased self esteem and self confidence)

On 7th March, 2019, Thursday we had a small group activity session to encourage the children. In that activity we have included the Disabled children along with the JMJ Kids Zone, Preschool children.

We had 3 activities namely 1. Blind Fold 2. Dumb Charades, 3. Building Pyramids. First we conducted Blind fold in that 10 children participated, they have to identify the things which they took in the basket.

Next in the second activity, based on action called dumb Charades. Ms jasmine acted and the children found the words about action.

Third Activity based on Ability on the children, they have to build a pyramid using the paper cups in time basis to calculate their motor skills level.

Ended the day with support of the almighty and completed the day with energy and potential.

CBR Tookkit Programme
